

YOUR CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS APPLY EVERYWHERE!

- “I will not open the door without a judicial warrant”
- “I would like to remain silent”

- “I would like to speak to a lawyer”
- “I will not sign anything without a lawyer”

IF ICE STOPS YOU IN PUBLIC:

- Provide valid documentation if you have it
- Say the following:
 - “I wish to remain silent”
 - “I would like to speak to a lawyer”
- Remember:
 - If detained, give your name and a family contact to a witness
 - Provide valid documentation if you have it



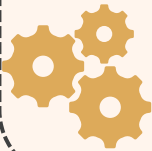
IF ICE COMES TO YOUR HOME:

- Do **NOT** open the door
 - Ask for a judicial warrant-ask them to show it through window or under the door
- Call your local rapid response hotline
- Remember:
 - You have the right document everything (noting descriptions of agents/car/badge number)



IF YOU SEE ICE AT WORK

- Notify your manager & staff
- You have the right to refuse consent to a search based on the 4th Amendment
- Find a private area
 - Ex: Office, bathroom, or closet
- Remember:
 - Agents cannot enter a private space without a warrant
 - You have the right to document



IF ICE STOPS YOU IN YOUR CAR:

- Ask why you are being stopped
- If driving, upon request, provide:
 - Driver's license; Car registration; Proof of Insurance
- Do **NOT** open your door or window!
 - Ask for a valid judicial warrant
- Remember:
 - Passengers do not have to provide identification



IF ICE COMES TO YOUR SCHOOL:

- Notify the principal and staff immediately
 - Say the following:
 - “I am not authorized to give you any information.”
- Find a private area
- Remember:
 - Schools & districts **cannot** share student information



WHAT TO DO IF DETAINED BY ICE (SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA)?:

1. Memorize phone numbers of friends/family/immigration attorneys

2. If you fear returning to your country, state it loudly and **ask for a Credible Fear Interview**
